### External Providers Extra-Curricular Activities – Autumn Term 2017

This term, we are pleased to be able to offer a number of clubs run by outside providers. These are in addition to our own clubs, and full details of this timetable are attached.

All the coaches in these clubs are fully insured, DBS checked and have the relevant coaching qualifications in their field. Our PE leader, Mr Morris, will be responsible for monitoring the quality of the coaching on offer, and ensuring that all club providers adhere to the same standards and quality of coaching as we would offer ourselves.

These clubs offer our children a valuable extension to the standard curriculum, and we hope that they will be a big success. As these outside providers are commercial ventures, the charges are more than the charges for our own clubs; however, we hope you will agree that they still represent excellent value for money and offer opportunities that your child may not be able to access otherwise.

Please note that if you wish to sign up your child/ren to any of these clubs, your agreement regarding attendance and payment is with the club provider, and not Hamworthy Park Junior School. The club provider will maintain their own registers, and will be responsible for discharging your child/ren into your care (or walking home if you have indicated this is allowed) after a club. Extra club letters are available from front office or online.

Please note all children will be dismissed at 4.15pm from the Year 6 exit onto the main playground. You will be able to wait for your child inside the main gates to the playground. If we experience bad weather, you will be allowed to wait in the Year 6 corridor.
