School Provided Extra-Curricular Activities – Spring Term 2018

We are writing to inform you about our exciting timetable of extra-curricular clubs taking place this Spring term. As a school, we aim to provide a wide range of before-school, after-school and lunchtime activities, so ensuring there is something to appeal to all our children.

Please note: The Spring timetable starts on MONDAY 22nd January 2018 and finish on FRIDAY 16th March 2018

We have Parent Consultation Evenings on Monday 19th and Wednesday 21st March, therefore, no clubs will run during that week

As you will see from the attached timetable, the range of activities is broad and exciting. We actively encourage children to get involved in extra-curricular activities as it offers them opportunities to mix with different children and allows them to develop new skills and talents. **Please note our clubs have limited spaces so we recommend that you sign your child up via ScoPay as soon as possible.**

All internal clubs must be paid for online via ScoPay. We are unable to accept cash or book your child in at school office

When signing up via ScoPay, please ensure you indicate whether your child will be collected, is able to walk home or will attend our Jet Set club. Successful payment is confirmation that your child has a place within the club you have booked.

When signing up your child, please ensure you read and understand the conditions of attendance; if a club has to be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances an email will be sent as soon as we become aware of the cancellation.

All External clubs (see separate letter) must be paid in cash, handed into the office in separate envelopes for each club, with your child's name, class, club requested and amount clearly written on the front. Please attach the form to the outside of envelope. Extra letters are available on-line or from office.

Please note that all monies received will be re-invested into the school Extra Curricular programme and we look forward to seeing your child enjoy their chosen activity. **All children will be dismissed at 4.15pm and will vacate from school into the main playground, using the extension in Year 6. You will be able to wait for your child inside the main gates to the playground. If we experience bad weather, you will be allowed to wait in the Year 6 corridor.**

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CONDITION OF ATTENDANCE.
