



# Curriculum Overview

## Year 3 Autumn Term



### Maths

This term we will be looking at identifying, ordering and comparing numbers up to 1000. The children will also practice their mental and written methods of addition using numbers up to 1000. To support your child, we would encourage them to practice their times tables in preparation for their weekly Friday challenge!

### English



This term we will be looking at narrative texts by authors Anthony Browne and Linda Sarah. The children will be using their reading skills to develop their vocabulary and understanding of the story. They will then apply this knowledge to their written work.

### Computing

In ICT, we will be learning how to log on the computers and be safe. We then be using the programme Expresso to code and create animated motions.



### Topic (Science, history or Geography)

Our topic this half term is based on *'Scavengers and Settlers'*. This will include looking at the life and culture of Prehistoric man from the Stone Age through the Iron Age and ending with the Bronze Age. The children will also be focusing and learning about the: art, food and farming developments of this time period.

### Art and Design technology



As a link to topic (Scavengers and Settlers), we will be using this opportunity to design and create items used in the stone age.

Linking to science (Healthy Me), the children will be partaking in cooking.

### Music

We will be learning a variety of simple songs whilst comparing the similarities and differences between rhythm and pitch. The children will also have the opportunity to make their very own instrument to perform with!

### R.E and PSHCE

Our first unit for RE will be Hinduism, through this we will be understanding their religion, gods and worship. In PSHCE, they will be learning about setting realistic goals and finding ways to achieve them.
